QUALIFICATIONS FOR VOTERS

According to education law, to be qualified to vote in a school district election, a person must be:

1. At least 18 years of age
2. A legal resident of the school district for 30 days to the date of the vote*
3. A citizen of the United States

*A person may have only one legal residence which is normally determined by a combination of the following:

1. The place that he or she votes in a federal, state, or local election
2. The place where he or she pays income taxes.
3. The place where his or her automobile is registered.

PROCEDURES FOR ABSENTEE BALLOTS

“The Board of Education authorizes the District Clerk or Board designee to provide Absentee Ballots to qualified District Voters. Absentee Ballots may be used for the election of School Board members and for adoption of the annual budget and referenda. A District voter must request in advance an application for an absentee ballot. The voter must complete the application and state the reason he/she will not be able to appear in person on the date of the District election. The application must be received by the District Clerk/designee at least seven days before the election if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or the day before the election if the ballot is to be delivered personally to the voter.

Pursuant to the provisions of Education Law, a District Voter is eligible to vote by absentee ballot under the following conditions: illness or physical disability; or business responsibilities or studies which require travel outside of the county or city of residence on the day of the election; or vacation outside of the county or city of residence; or detention or confinement to jail after conviction for an offense other than a felony.

An Absentee Ballot must reach the office of the District Clerk/designee not later than 5 pm on the day of the election. A list of all persons to whom Absentee Ballots have been issued shall be maintained by the District Clerk/designee and made available for public inspection. Any qualified voter challenging the acceptance of an Absentee Ballot must file a written statement with the District Clerk/designee or inform the election inspectors on the day of the District election.”

Any District resident qualified to vote at this election and needed to use an Absentee Ballot should contact the District Clerk’s office, 203 East Main Street, Westfield, NY 14787 (716-326-2151) to request an application. An application for an absentee ballot must be received by the District Clerk at least seven days before the election if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter or the day before the election, if the voter will be picking up the ballot in person.

Absentee Application Education Law, Section 2018B

Application must be received by the District Clerk at least seven days before the election, if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter or the day before the election, if the ballot is to be delivered personally to the voter.

I am a qualified voter of the School District in which I reside in that I am or will be on such date over 18 years of age, a citizen of the United States, and have or will have resided in the district thirty days next preceding such date.
